## Yaskawa Solectria Solar's U.S. Made XGI 1500 Inverters and Company Compliance with FEOC Restrictions

The term Foreign Entity of Concern (FEOC) refers to companies or organizations linked to countries that are considered national security risks to the United States. These may include companies based in China, Russia, Iran and North Korea—all are subject to strict U.S. trade, technology, and intellectual property regulations. Under the latest federal provisions, solar projects that involve FEOCs in key components or services may lose access to critical tax incentives, such as the Investment Tax Credit (ITC) and the Production Tax Credit (PTC). 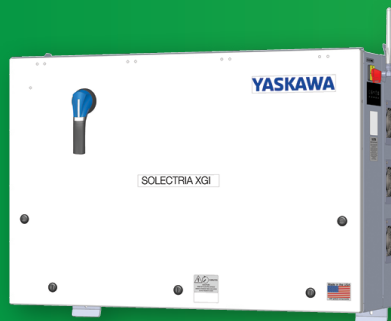
